## **16 mm Polypropylene Climbing Nets Installation Recommendations**

Nets are made with 16 mm polypropylene rope, hand knotted together and as standard come with 100 mm loops at the top and bottom. The net will come with a label indicating the top.

These nets can be fitted in various way depending on the application of the net, on how it's being used and what it's being fitted too.

The nets have been manufactured in accordance with BSEN1176/77 and should be installed as per these guidelines.

- We recommend a timber size no larger than 95 mm diameter is used by threading it through the 100 mm loops.
- The timber should then be bolted or clamped into position.
- This application can be used for the top and bottom of the net.
- The bottom of the net can also be secured into the ground by using ground anchors, these can be purchased using code SWP\_GA via our online shop.
- The ground anchors should be driven into the ground at a 90-degree angle to the net.

The net must be fitted as taut as possible, any slack or movement in the net will increase the wear.

Recommended user weight is approx. 100 kilos at any one time.

Supervision is always needed when the net is being used by children.
